

Weed Committee Report – GLA Board Meeting – 12-18-2017

As formulated at the October 24th Weed Committee Meeting, and presented at the October 30th GLA Board Meeting, and subsequently tabled at the November 27th GLA Board Meeting, the Chairman of the Weed Committee will enter the following motions:

Motion #1 - The Weed Committee makes a motion to contract with Rollins Aquatic for the 2018 season to treat 15 acres on Goose Lake, 10 acres on Beaver Lake and 12 acres on Lincoln Lake at a cost of \$22,390.

Motion #2 – The Weed Committee makes a motion to expand the Muck Mitigation program in 2018 to the five finger channels and Muskie Trail to the end of the island at a cost of \$7500, to be professionally applied by Rollins Aquatic Solutions.

Post Meeting Notes: After much discussions by some board members looking to cut back on the weed program and further unnecessarily delay the vote another month, as Weed Committee Chairman I could not let our successful and consistent maintenance of the invasive species of aquatic plants be arbitrarily cut or eliminated as suggested buy one of the board members, so I put forth the motion for the weeds (Motion #1 above) and compromised by tabling the Muck Mitigation program to the next meeting in January.
